The panel decided to confirm the current interim conditions of practice order.

A panel will be invited by the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) to confirm the interim conditions of practice order at this meeting and Ms Guansing will be notified of the panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, or there has been a request for an early review, a panel will review the interim order at a hearing which Ms Guansing will be invited to attend in person, send a representative on Ms Guansing's behalf or submit written representations for the panel to consider. At any such review hearing the panel may revoke the interim order, it may confirm the interim conditions of practice order or it may replace it with an interim conditions of practice order.

This will be confirmed to Ms Guansing in writing.
