Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to continue the interim suspension order.

Unless Miss Roberts' case has already been concluded or there has been a material change of circumstances, the panel will review the interim suspension order at a review meeting within the next six months and every six months thereafter. The panel will be invited by the NMC to confirm the interim order at this meeting and Miss Roberts will be notified of the panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, or there has been a request for an early review, a panel will review the interim order at a hearing which Miss Roberts will be invited to attend in person, send a representative on her behalf or submit written representations for the panel to consider.

The NMC Case Examiners are yet to decide whether there is a case to answer in relation to the allegations made against Miss Roberts. The NMC will write to Miss Roberts when the case is ready for the next stage of the fitness to practise process.

This will be confirmed to Miss Roberts in writing.
