## Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to make an interim suspension order for a period of 18 months.

The panel directs that a review hearing be listed in or around fourteen days. At this hearing Mr Mubwandarikwa will have the opportunity to make representations as to the current interim order. The review hearing will reconsider the interim order in full.

Additionally, unless Mr Mubwandarikwa's case has already been concluded, this interim order must be reviewed before the end of the next six months and every six months thereafter.

At any review the reviewing panel may revoke the interim order or any condition of it, it may confirm the interim order, or vary any condition of it, or it may replace the interim conditions of practice order with an interim suspension order.

The NMC Case Examiners are yet to decide whether there is a case to answer in relation to the allegations made against Mr Mubwandarikwa. The NMC will write to Mr Mubwandarikwa when the case is ready for the next stage of the fitness to practise process.

This will be confirmed to Mr Mubwandarikwa in writing.
