## Nursing and Midwifery Council Agreed Removal Decision

On 16 March 2023 we received a referral raising a concern about Fiona Prior's fitness to practise. It's alleged that she lacked competence in her role in the areas of: medicines management and administration; equipment and resource knowledge/management; prioritisation of patient care and managing her workload.

We investigated the issue and the matter was referred to our Fitness to Practise Committee. No allegation against Fiona Prior has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees. On 28 April 2024 we received an application from Fiona Prior for agreed removal from the NMC Register.

## ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC Register in this case because:

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Fiona Prior's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- comments received from the person that made the allegation against Fiona Prior
- details of the concerns and Fiona Prior's response to them
- the interests of Fiona Prior
- the public interest

## I'm satisfied that:

- Fiona Prior no longer intends to work as a registered nurse,
- the allegations against Fiona Prior are not so serious as to be fundamentally incompatible with continued registration,
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time.
- the public interest is best served by the immediate removal of Fiona Prior's name from the NMC Register.

This record of decision will be published for twelve months from the date of the decision, 19 June 2024. In the event that Fiona Prior seeks readmission to the Register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
