## **Decision and reasons on interim order**

The panel decided to confirm the current interim suspension order.

Unless Miss Smith's case has already been concluded or there has been a material change of circumstances, a panel will review the interim suspension order at a review meeting within the next six months and every six months thereafter. A panel will be invited by the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) to confirm the interim suspension order at this meeting and Miss Smith will be notified of that panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Alternatively, Miss Smith is entitled to have the interim suspension order reviewed at a hearing. This means that Miss Smith will be able to attend and make representations, send a representative on her behalf or submit written representations about whether the order continues to be necessary. Miss Smith must inform her case officer if she would like the interim suspension order to be reviewed at a hearing.

Even if Miss Smith does not request a hearing, where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, a panel will review the order at a hearing to which Miss Smith and her representative will be invited to attend.

This decision will be confirmed to Miss Smith in writing.
