## **Decision and reasons on interim order**

The panel decided to confirm the current interim suspension order.

Unless there has been a material change of circumstances, a panel will review the interim suspension order at an administrative meeting within the next six months. The reviewing panel will be invited by the NMC to confirm the order at this meeting and Ms Afolabi will be notified of that panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Alternatively, Ms Afolabi is entitled to have the interim suspension order reviewed at a hearing. This means that Ms Afolabi will be able to attend and make representations, send a representative on her behalf or submit written representations about whether the order continues to be necessary. Ms Afolabi must inform her case officer if she would like the interim suspension order to be reviewed at a hearing.

Even if Ms Afolabi does not request a hearing, where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, a panel will review the order at a hearing to which Ms Afolabi and her representative will be invited to attend.

This decision will be confirmed to Ms Afolabi in writing.
