## Nursing and Midwifery Council Agreed Removal Decision

On 14 January 2021 we received a referral raising a concern about Delphine Alexandra Gallimore's fitness to practise. The allegations relate to lack of competence – medication administration; poor record-keeping; and poor wound management.

We investigated the issue and the matter was referred to the Fitness to Practise Committee for adjudication. No allegation against Delphine Alexandra Gallimore has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees. On 6 March 2024 we received an application from Delphine Alexandra Gallimore for agreed removal from the NMC Register.

## ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal. I have agreed to Delphine Alexandra Gallimore's removal from the NMC Register in this case for the reasons summarised below.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Delphine Alexandra Gallimore's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- the agreed removal application form and associated correspondence
- the Case Examiners' decision letter
- the NMC investigation completion report
- the interests of Delphine Alexandra Gallimore
- the public interest

We sought to contact the person that made the allegation about Delphine Alexandra Gallimore for their comments on the application for agreed removal. No comments were received within a reasonable period.

## I'm satisfied that:

 Delphine Alexandra Gallimore no longer intends to work as a registered nurse,

- the allegations against Delphine Alexandra Gallimore are not so serious as to be fundamentally incompatible with continued registration,
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time,
- the public interest is best served by the immediate removal of Delphine Alexandra Gallimore's name from the NMC Register.

This record of decision will be published for twelve months from the date of the decision, **10 May 2024**. In the event Delphine Alexandra Gallimore seeks readmission to the Register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
