Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to confirm the current interim suspension order.

Unless there has been a material change of circumstances, a panel will review the interim conditions of practice order at an administrative meeting within the next six months. The reviewing panel will be invited by the NMC to confirm the order at this meeting and Ms Nyable will be notified of that panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Alternatively, Ms Nyable is entitled to have the interim conditions of practice order reviewed at a hearing. This means that Ms Nyable will be able to attend and make representations, send a representative on her behalf or submit written representations about whether the order continues to be necessary. Ms Nyable must inform her case officer if she would like the interim conditions of practice order to be reviewed at a hearing.

Even if Ms Nyable does not request a hearing, where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, a panel will review the order at a hearing to which Ms Nyable and her representative will be invited to attend.

This decision will be confirmed to Ms Nyable in writing.

That concludes this determination.

Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to **EITHER**
confirm the current interim suspension order
refer this case to a hearing.

Unless Ms Nyable's case has already been concluded or there has been a material change of circumstances, a panel will review the interim suspension order at a review meeting within the next six months and every six months thereafter. A panel will be invited by the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) to confirm the interim suspension order at this meeting and Ms Nyable will be notified of the panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, or there has been a request for an early review, a panel will review the interim order at a hearing which Ms Nyable will be invited to attend in person, send a representative on Ms Nyable's behalf or submit written representations for the panel to consider. At any such review hearing the panel may revoke the interim order, it may confirm the interim suspension order or it may replace it with an interim conditions of practice order.

OR

Fraudulent entry cases only

A panel of the Investigating Committee has still to deal with the allegations made against Ms Nyable. The NMC will keep Ms Nyable informed of developments in relation to that issue.

This will be confirmed to Ms Nyable in writing.

That concludes this determination.

OR

Only for cases dealt with by FtPC

A panel of the Fitness to Practise Committee has still to deal with the allegations made against Ms Nyable. The NMC will keep Ms Nyable informed of developments in relation to that issue.

This will be confirmed to Ms Nyable in writing.

That concludes this determination.
