Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to confirm the current interim conditions of practice order.

Unless Miss Olaigbade's case has already been concluded or there has been a material change of circumstances, a panel will review the interim conditions of practice order at a review meeting within the next six months and every six months thereafter. A panel will be invited by the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) to confirm the interim conditions of practice order at this meeting and Miss Olaigbade will be notified of the panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, or there has been a request for an early review, a panel will review the interim order at a hearing which Miss Olaigbade will be invited to attend in person, send a representative on Miss Olaigbade's behalf or submit written representations for the panel to consider. At any such review hearing the panel may revoke the interim order, it may confirm the interim conditions of practice order or it may replace it with a suspension order.

This will be confirmed to Miss Olaigbade in writing.
