Agreed Removal Decision

On 5 February 2024 we received a referral raising a concern about Jacqueline Ann Jones' fitness to practise. It's alleged she didn't respond adequately when a resident had a fall and then later used a chair to stop the resident getting out of bed.

Jaqueline Ann Jones accepts the concerns raised against her. The NMC investigation isn't finished and no allegation against Jacqueline Ann Jones has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 17 August 2024 we received an application from Jacqueline Ann Jones for agreed removal from the NMC register.

ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Jacqueline Ann Jones's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- the referral to the NMC and accompanying documents
- the fact that there's no evidence of any deep-seated problems with Jacqueline Ann Jones' attitude as a nurse
- comments received from the person that made the allegation against Jacqueline Ann Jones
- the interests of Jacqueline Ann Jones
- the public interest.

I'm satisfied that:

- Jacqueline Ann Jones no longer intends to work as a registered nurse
- the allegations against Jacqueline Ann Jones are not so serious as to be fundamentally incompatible with continued registration
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time

• the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Jacqueline Ann Jones to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, 21 October 2024. In the event that Jacqueline Ann Jones seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
