Agreed Removal Decision

On 15 September 2020 we received a referral raising a concern about Hayley Leanne Mortimore's fitness to practise. It's alleged that on 2 September 2020 she administered the incorrect dose of a prescribed medication, and falsified the medication records to cover this error. Hayley Leanne Mortimore admits to making a medication error, but says she can't remember falsifying any documents.

We investigated the issue and the matter was referred to the Fitness to Practise Committee. No allegation against Hayley Leanne Mortimore has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 2 August 2024 we received an application from Hayley Leanne Mortimore for agreed removal from the NMC register.

ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Hayley Leanne Mortimore's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- Hayley Leanne Mortimore's agreed removal application form and supporting documents
- the case examiner decision
- evidence obtained in the case
- the interests of Hayley Leanne Mortimore
- the public interest.

We sought to contact the person who made the allegation against Hayley Leanne Mortimore for their comments on the application for agreed removal. No comments were received within a reasonable period.

I'm satisfied that:

- Hayley Leanne Mortimore no longer intends to work as a registered nurse

- the allegations against Hayley Leanne Mortimore are not so serious as to be fundamentally incompatible with continued registration
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Hayley Leanne Mortimore to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, 30 September 2024. In the event that Hayley Leanne Mortimore seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
