Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to replace the interim conditions of practice order with an interim suspension order.

At any time, you or the NMC may ask for the interim order to be reviewed by a panel if any relevant new information becomes available.

At any review, a panel may revoke it, it may confirm the interim suspension order, or it may replace it with an interim conditions of practice order. In certain circumstances, it may be possible for the interim order to be reviewed by a panel at an administrative meeting. Your case officer will write to you about this in due course.

You should notify the NMC immediately of any material change of circumstances that may affect the interim order.

This decision will be confirmed to you in writing.

The NMC Case Examiners are yet to decide whether there is a case to answer in relation to the allegations made against you. The NMC will write to you when the case is ready for the next stage of the fitness to practise process.

That concludes this determination.
