Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to confirm the current interim conditions of practice order.

Unless there has been a material change of circumstances, a panel will review the interim conditions of practice order at an administrative meeting within the next six months. The reviewing panel will be invited by the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) to confirm the order at this meeting and Miss Pile will be notified of that panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Alternatively, Miss Pile is entitled to have the interim conditions of practice order reviewed at a hearing. This means that Miss Pile will be able to attend and make representations, send a representative on her behalf or submit written representations about whether the order continues to be necessary. Miss Pile must inform her case officer if she would like the interim conditions of practice order to be reviewed at a hearing.

Even if Miss Pile does not request a hearing, where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, a panel will review the order at a hearing to which Miss Pile and her representative will be invited to attend.

This decision will be confirmed to Miss Pile in writing.
