## **Note of Correction to the Programme Approval Visit Report, Edge Hill University, Preregistration Nursing**

The programme approval report for preregistration nursing programmes at Edge Hill University (dated 2 March 2020) provides a detailed narrative of how simulated practice learning (SPL) has been appropriately considered by independent Quality Assurance (QA) visitors, within the context of the proposed programme routes.

This report was reviewed for factual accuracy by Edge Hill University and QA visitors at the time. However, our analysis of the mandatory exceptional report 2024 highlighted an inaccuracy in the report: it understates the number of SPL hours requested by Edge Hill University in their application and therefore considered by our QA visitors during the approval process.

There is evidence in QA link to support the original number of SPL hours requested in the application was higher than reported.

On this basis, we are issuing this note of correction to confirm that Edge Hill University are approved by the NMC to deliver 440 hours of simulated practice learning in their undergraduate preregistration nursing programmes and 240 hours in their postgraduate preregistration nursing programmes.
