#### SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

The School has 200 staff and over 3000 students and is spread across 7 departments and is one of nine within Kings College London. The Teacher and Mentor Programmes are located in the School of Nursing. The University is a member of the Russell Group of 20 major research intensive institutions; The National Nursing Research Unit is the only DOH funded unit in England. The School is at the forefront of academic health science with the formation of the Kings Health Partners Academic Health Science Centre. The University is awaiting the outcome of the pan London tendering exercise for pre-registration nursing adult field.

The programme lead for the Preparation for Mentorship Programme and the deputy programme lead for the Teacher Programme have current NMC registration and also hold NMC Teacher Qualifications. Staff are actively involved in research and service development and hold posts with major NHS Trust partners. Applications to the programmes are by completion of a written application form and telephone interviews with confirmation of suitability to enter by the line manager.

The School has extensive links both within the UK and across the globe. Partners and collaborators include education, professional and research institutes both nationally and internationally with visiting academics from these institutions. Links with partners are exceptional with 50 contracts for provision of services both academic and a range of activities.

All areas are audited and all students are allocated a suitable mentor. Fitness for practice is confirmed through completion of NCM Learning Outcomes verified by the external examiner. Quality assurance procedures meet both College and NMC requirements.
