

Who are practice supervisors and how are they prepared?

The practice supervisor can be <u>any registered health and social care professional</u> working in a practice environment. They've been <u>prepared and supported</u> to take up their role and have <u>up-to-date knowledge and experience</u> relevant to the student they are supervising.

All nurses, midwives and nursing associates in any practice learning environment should be able to undertake a practice supervisor role.
